The report recommends the following zoning changes:

- Creating a Medical Office Overlay zone along the entire length of Teaneck Road (see pages 17-25 in the report*)
- Creating a **hotel zone** on the Siegel & Siegel building (300 Route 4 East) and the adjacent township-owned lot (total 2.15 acres) **for a hotel with a minimum of 100 rooms**, dining facilities, meeting rooms and exercise facilities. (see pages 25-28 in the report*)
- Creating a hotel zone on 5 tree-filled acres of the township-owned Route
 4 buffer located between the Alfred Avenue industrial area and Route 4.
 Selling or leasing this township-owned land. (see pages 25-28 in the report*)
- Allowing billboards in Teaneck in the hotel zone (pages 26-28 in the report*)
- Rezoning the intersection of Teaneck Road and Fort Lee Road for B-2 business uses, along with a Medical Office Overlay zone (see pages 28-29 in the report*)

The Teaneck Master Plan should guide policy changes to keep zoning and development consistent with the township's vision.
